

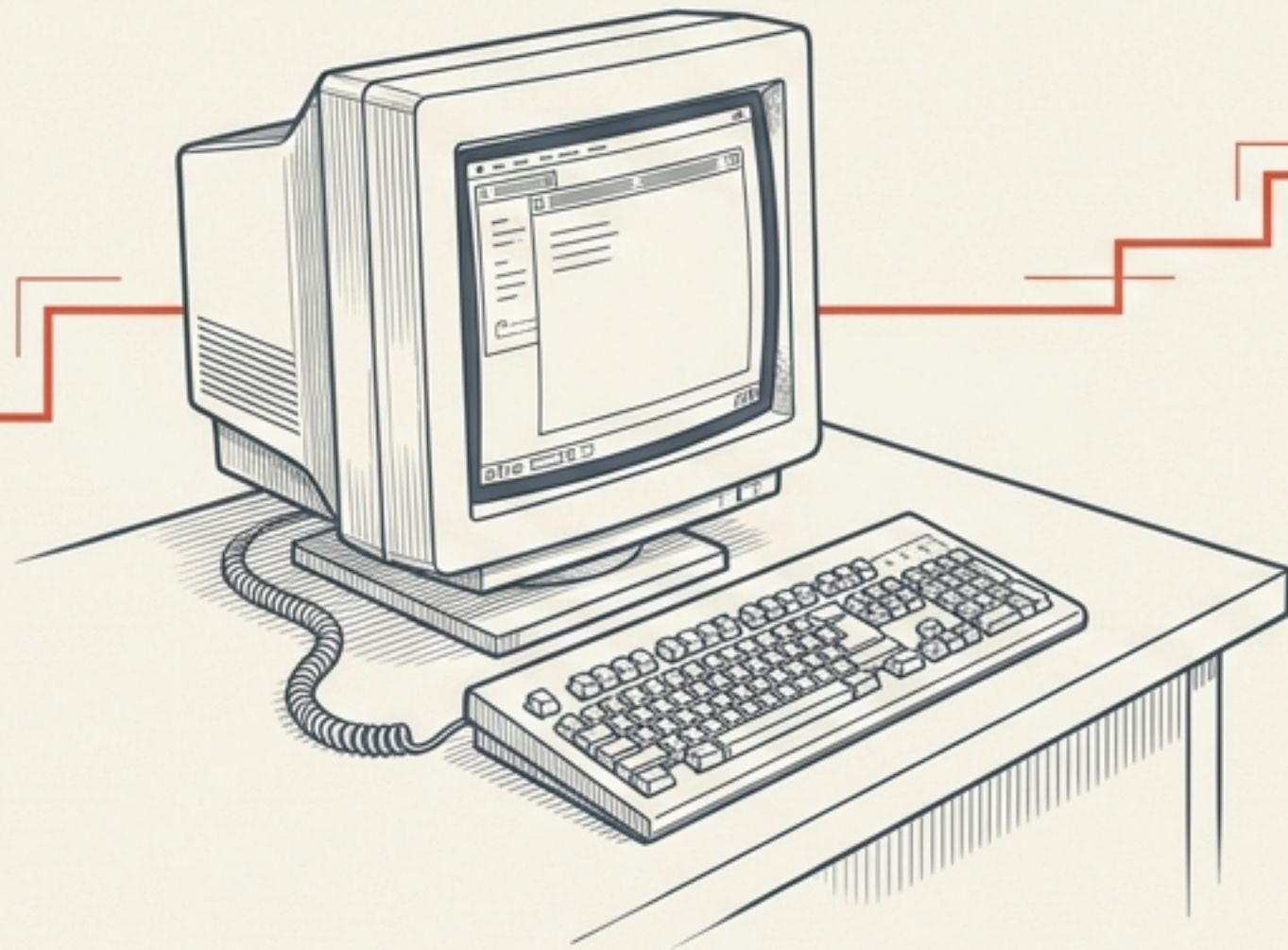

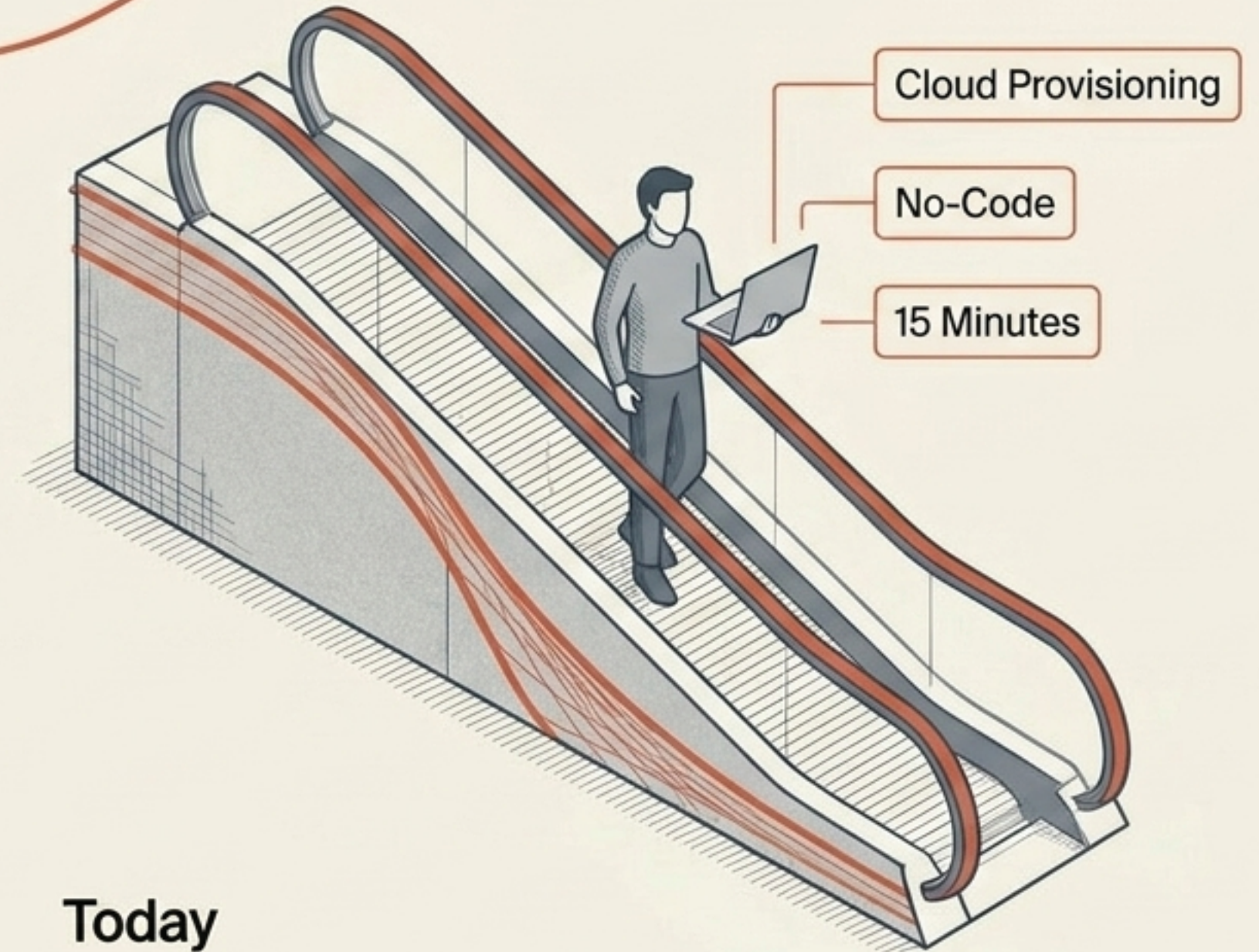
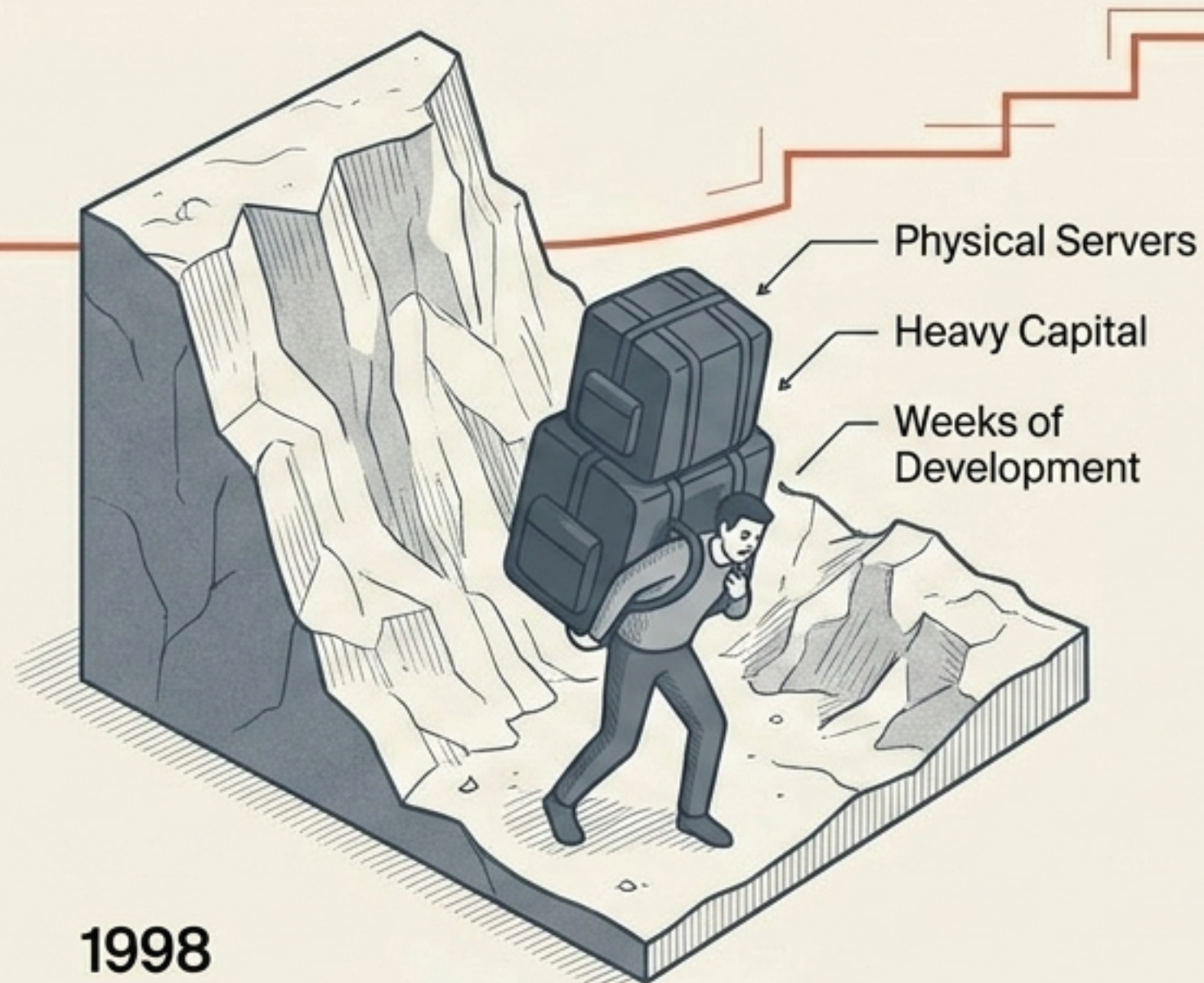

The Collapse of Physical Friction



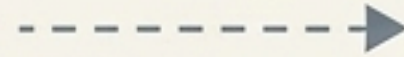

Borders Disappeared

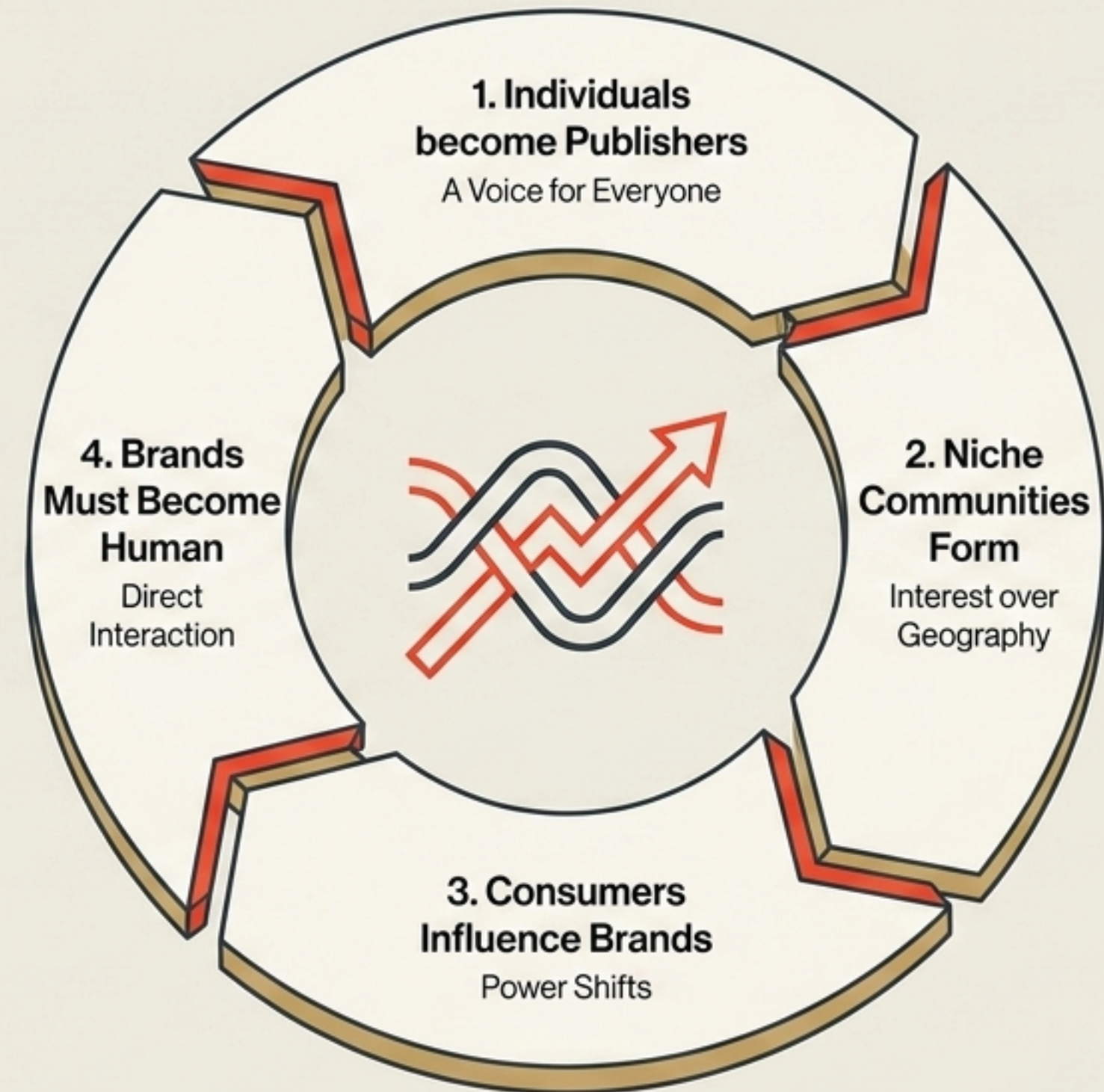
Billions now communicate instantly across languages and time zones. The futuristic became entirely normal.

Digital signatures replace wet ink.

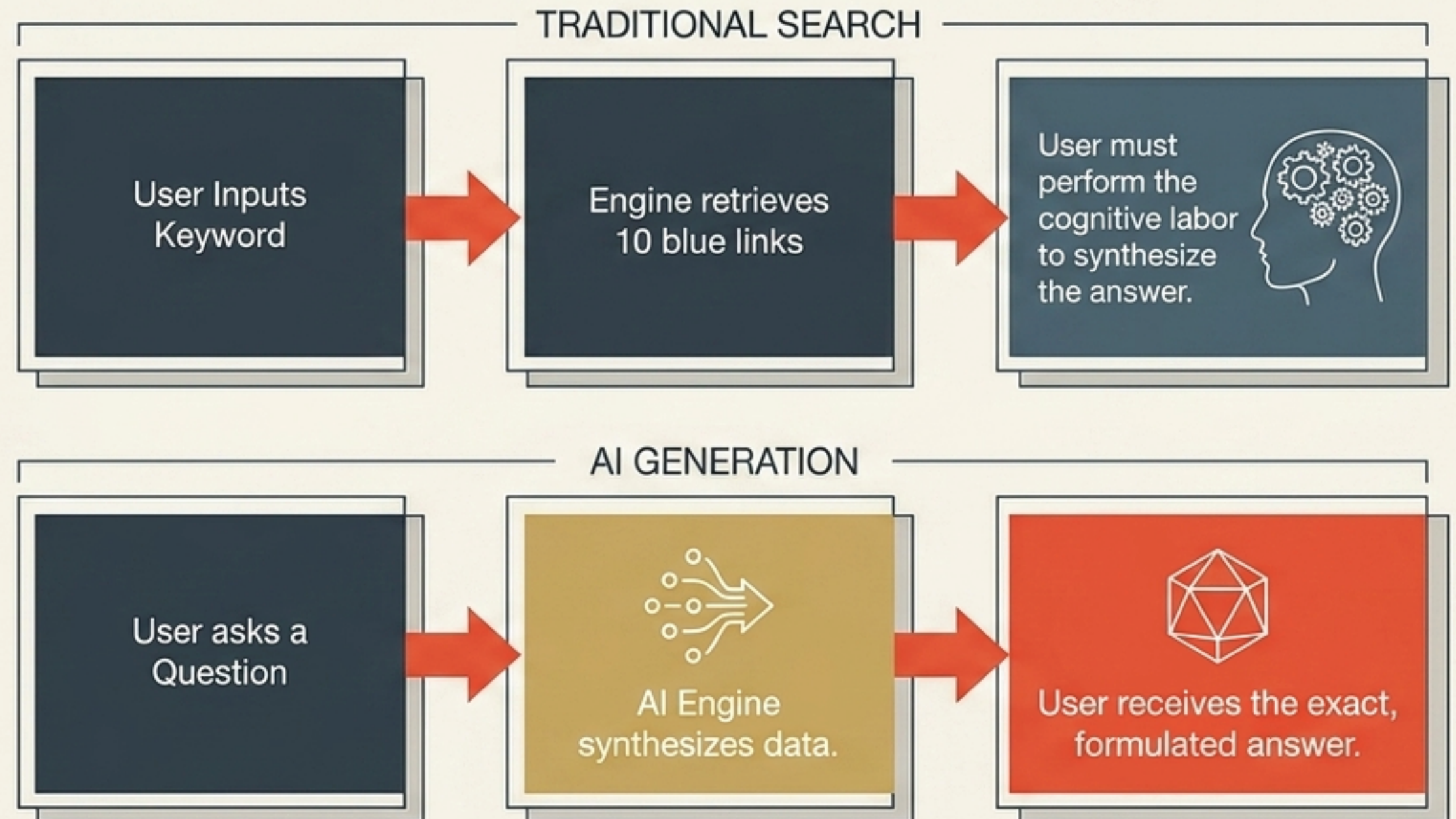
Remote work gains structural acceptance.

For two decades, search meant discovering links. Today, humans are asking questions.

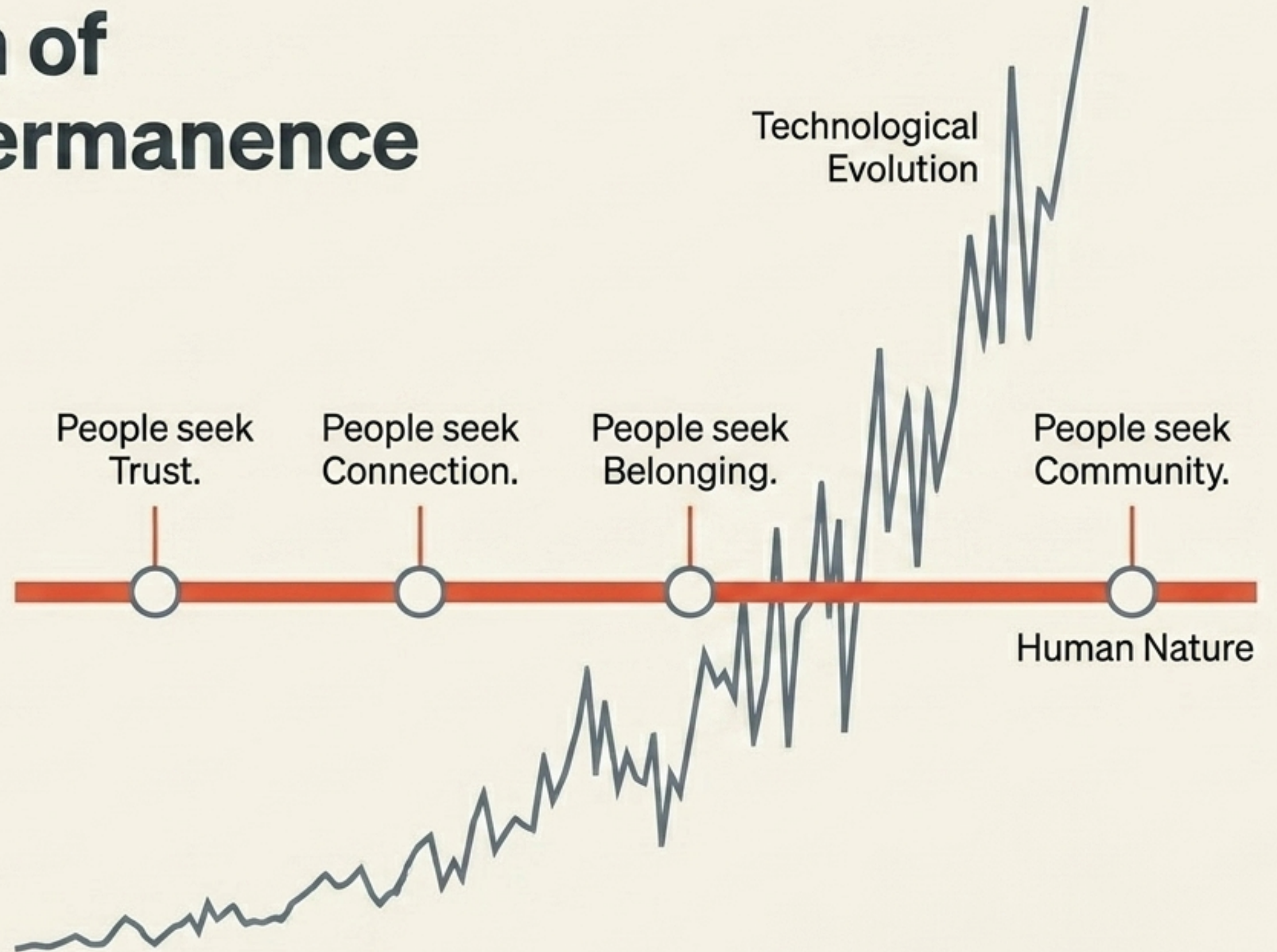
